WHAT

Identify specific application or features being used.

WHEN

Pinpoint the exact time and for how long the licenses are being used.

WHERE

Locate where the licenses are being used.



Determine the user of the license and the

corresponding department.

HOW

Assess whether the licenses are being maximized or underutilized.

> SLM includes monitoring, analyzing, and optimizing the usage of applications with different licensing models, whether they are license manager-enabled, standalone, or cloud-based.

Licensing Model

Licenses come in different models such as perpetual, pay-per-use, concurrent, user-locked, node-locked, and subscription-based.

License Manager

A software that manages the licenses of an application through license allocation and administration. Examples of functions include Allow, Reserve, Deny, and Limit, as

> well as restarting/shutting down of license servers.

Standalone

In a standalone licensing model, the license is tied to where the application is installed and does not require a license manager.

Cloud

Software-as-a-Service is a software distribution model where the applications are hosted in a cloud environment. Users can access the software via the internet.
